COURSE INTRODUCTION

With the Bachelor of Design specialising in Fashion Design, students have an opportunity to **foster design thinking, growth and innovation within fashion design, especially in relation to sustainable fashion.** Inscape provides graduates with the **much sought after knowledge and skills to gain access to a wide range of careers within the fashion industry.** Fashion students learn how to problem solve in various contexts by studying design theories, professional practices and applying experiential learning.

Graduates from the programme may continue with their studies at a postgraduate level, for instance the BA Honours in Design offered by Inscape.

COURSE OVERVIEW

- **Equips students with design thinking and problem-solving skills needed for creative idea generation in the fashion field.**
- **Students consider cultures, sub-cultures and an individuals' sense of style, when working with patterns, clothing, textiles, sustainable and related materials.**
- **Research and analysis of current trends** including sustainable fashion and circular economy approaches to re-use, repurpose and recycle support students in **their aim of creating new and innovative fashion products.**
- Students are encouraged to play a role in multidisciplinary teams **in using fashion design to address challenges linked to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG).**
- **Conceptualising design solutions,** drafting and manipulating flat patterns and constructing garments for multi-cultural markets.
- **Digitally creating fashion illustrations using computer-aided design, and planning** and implementing media strategies to promote their fashion brand, concepts and products.
- This approach supports 'sustainable learning' that students will be able to carry over into their careers and a variety of contexts.
- Students **are well prepared as fashion design practitioners** to contribute meaningfully in complex and fast changing real-world contexts through the inclusion of **'live briefs' for industry clients, job shadowing and experiential learning.**

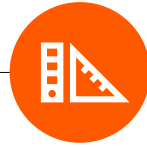

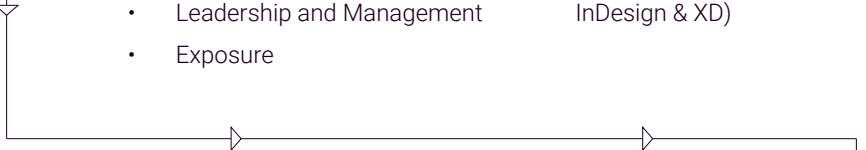

COURSE STRUCTURE



- ✓ 3 Years full time
- ✓ NQF level 7
- ✓ 8 x 1h 45 min sessions per week.
- ✓ Approximately 2.5 hours additional independent study per session.
- ✓ 40 hours Job shadowing to be completed in the second year.
- ✓ 240 hours Experiential Training completed in the third year.
- ✓ Innovative continuous project-based assessment.
- ✓ Portfolio showcase of select work completed in the second and third year.
- ✓ Personalised capstone project with portfolio of evidence and written report submitted in the third year.

ARTICULATION OPTIONS

Students who have graduated with the Bachelor of Design specialising in Fashion Design may apply for the Inscape BA Honours in Design if they have an average of over 60% in their final year of studies or may apply for the Advanced Diploma in User Experience at Inscape. Graduates may qualify for an Honours or Postgraduate Diploma in Fashion Design or a related field. Institutional minimum requirements will apply.

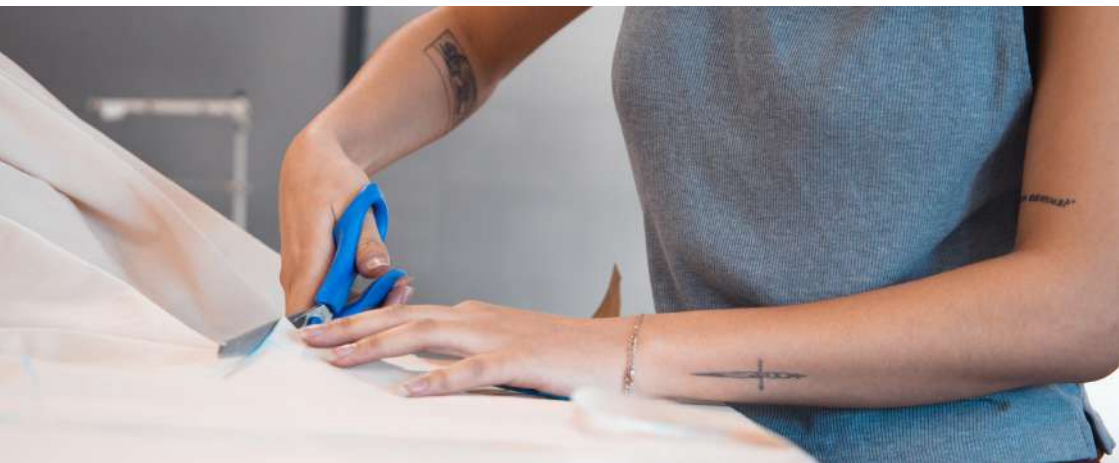
